# 2021 Waterside Summer Event

# Aim:

To provide an event with the same Classes over a known Waterside course thanking the Paddling Community for their continued support of NCC.

# **Description:**

A timed event similar to RACE B. Same classes, Same route. Similar Start and Finish Windows.

#### **Entries:**

A limit of 120 crews. Focusing on 2021 Juniors and then past entrants of the Waterside Series. £5.00 per seat. (no Team event). Entry List will be published periodically on the website.

#### Start:

Starting at 60 Second intervals. (0930 – 1200) Start time selected of remaining available at time of checkin. Start will be as RACE B. Opposite the NCC Club house.

### Turn:

Anti-Clockwise turn as normal: keep right on approach, out early, keeping right, turn round bollard, Keep right, in early and paddle away keeping right.

#### Finish:

Plan your start time to finish within the finish window of 1300 - 1500. (1500 will be flexible for the slower paddlers as is normal)

#### Marshals:

More than normal at various positions, to aid passage at certain locks / Bridges for all users - on towpath and on the Water. Also at the known low bridges. Club Members, plus known helpers with experience.

## **Advertising to Non-Canoeing Canal users:**

Flyers provided to narrow boat hire companies. Lock gates. Towpath strategic locations. Also Upstream and downstream of the Course for canal users entering area.
